Peguis Child and Family Services is seeking a compassionate and dedicated Specialized Foster Parent to join our Resource Homes team. This role provides trauma-informed, high-quality care to children and youth with complex needs.

The Specialized Foster Parent will reside in the agency Resource Home during each 7-day on-duty rotation, creating a stable, nurturing, and structured environment. This role requires full availability during on-duty periods to respond to the needs and potential crises of children and youth. The successful candidate will also support and supervise staff ensuring consistent, high-quality care.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide a safe, structured, and supportive home environment for children and youth.
- Support youth in daily routines, activities, and personal goals.
- Supervise children and youth with complex behavioral, emotional, or developmental needs.
- Maintain consistent routines, including meals, chores, recreation, and outings.
- Respond to emergencies or crises during on-duty periods.
- Perform household duties (cooking, cleaning, shopping).
- Document critical incidents and maintain accurate records.
- Supervise support workers and casual respite staff, ensuring compliance with Agency policies and high standards of care.
- Collaborate with caseworkers, clinicians, and other professionals.
