The ideal candidate is patient, professional, reliable, and committed to supporting vulnerable children and youth, including those with complex behavioural and high-risk needs.

Responsibilities

- Provide active supervision and ensure children's safety and well-being.
- Be a positive role model and respond appropriately during crises.
- Assist with daily routines, meals, hygiene, household chores, and recreation.
- Administer medications as directed and maintain accurate documentation.
- Transport children to appointments and activities as required.
- Complete daily logs and incident reports in accordance with Agency policies.



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Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent.
- Experience working with children and youth.
- Valid First Aid/CPR (or willingness to obtain).
- Valid driver's license and reliable insured vehicle (\$2 million liability).
- Ability to work the required shifts.
- Satisfactory Criminal Record Check (Vulnerable Sector), Child Abuse Registry, Adult Abuse Registry, drug screening, and prior contact checks
